Dear Parent(s),



I need your help. Recently, some children have been bringing in toys/items that are not related to school or their educational experience in my classroom. Unfortunately, it has resulted in some problems (hurt feelings) both inside and outside of the classroom. Most importantly, students are becoming distracted by these items while trying to learn in class. To eliminate these unnecessary problems, I have informed **all students that they are not allowed to bring in any items that are toys.** I told them that if they are unsure whether their item is a toy or not, they should probably just keep it at home.

Furthermore, children do not need to bring in extra supplies (markers, special pencils, pencil toppers, folders, etc.) to have at school. I have supplied them with everything they will need to start the school year. These extra items can cause children to become distracted as well (wanting to open and close desks when it is instruction/work time).
